Who is Dr. Wally?

Dr. Wallace R. Johnston (1937-2007), commonly known as "Dr. Wally" was a Virginia Amateur Sports founding board member, a columnist, commentator, speaker and long-time management professor at VCU. His columns and commentaries on work and workplace issues have been carried in the Richmond Times Dispatch, St. Louis Post Dispatch and syndicated to fifteen other newspapers. His radio show was on public radio WCVE 89.1 FM.

Johnston published more than three hundred academic and trade articles and two books, "Speaking of Work" and "What Every Manager Needs to Know." He also published two training videos titled, "The Metaphor of the Frog" and "Work Smart."

Friends, colleagues and former students raised \$30,000 to name a room in his honor at The New School of Business at VCU.
