GENERAL INFORMATION & POLICIES

- Upon arrival all exhibitors must check in with Show Office and present a copy of a current negative coggins report to the show secretary for each horse brought on the grounds. Current health papers (within 30 days) or appropriate equine passport are required for horses brought in from out of state.
- Liberty Equestrian Center will follow USEF Helmet rules. All exhibitors must wear ASTM/SEI helmets at all time while mounted on the show grounds. No helmet can protect the wearer against all foreseeable injuries., See Article 318
 - A minimum of 6 ribbons and prizes will be awarded for each class. In addition Champion and Reserve Champion awards for each Division as well as Team Awards in Hunter Seat and Western. Point systems used will be 10-6-4-2-1-0.5 for places 1-6.
 - Schooling and lunging only in designated areas. See information posted in Show Office.
 - Arenas will be open for Schooling Friday @ 4pm, posted hours on show days see Show Office.

Note any discounts also require pre-payment. Via mail prior to 7/1/16. Credit cards payment will be available after 7/1/16 call Gwen at 513-839-5619. All entries are asked to leave an open check or credit card on file, for all additional entries or charges.

- Facility will be open for mine in Friday, 7/29 @ noon. All stalls must be moved out by Monday, 8/1 @ 10 am unless other arrangements have been made in the Show Office.
 - No smoking in any of the barns or facilities.
 - Dogs/Pets MUST be on a leash
- No trash or sharps in the manure pits or stalls. Put sharps in specially marked containers in the barns and not in trash cans.
- Loss, theft, accident or disturbance should be reported to the LUEC staff. Lost and Found is located in the Show Office.
 - Golf carts/scooters are allowed but must be driven by licensed drivers in a safe manner.
 - No firearms or fireworks are permitted.
 - No camping or campfires are permitted.
- You are required to follow all parking signs and requests. Parking map will be posted in the show office and stabling areas.
 - Horses may not be kept in trailers overnight.
 - Horses may not be ponied behind any moving vehicles.



VIRGINIA COMMONWEALTH GAMES TEAM GUIDELINES

Two DISCIPLINES – Hunter Seat and Western A TEAM is comprised of 3 riders.

Within each discipline, there are three divisions:

- 1. Collegiate Division Riders must be a student, instructor, alumnus or enrolled incoming freshman of the college they represent. This is NOT a collegiate sanctioned event and therefore NOT subject to NCAA or athletic department rules, etc.
- 2. Youth Division Riders 19 years old and under who have not yet graduated high school. Any three riders may make a team NOT affiliated with any school.
- 3. Open Division Riders may be any age.

Other rules:

- Riders are not limited as to the number of classes they may enter
- A Rider may NOT ride on more than one team
- Western team scores will be calculated by totaling the points of the highest ribbon earned by the team in
 - 1) a western pleasure class
 - 2) a horsemanship class
 - 3) a showmanship class
 - Plus and other three classes, for a total of 6 scores

Western Guidelines

Western horses and ponies shall be of any breed or combination of breeds, serviceably sound, in good condition and of stock horse type. To be ridden and shown with Western attire, long sleeve shirt and boots. The use of spurs or chaps is optional. Helmets are recommended for all classes.

Hackamores and snaffle bits are permitted for junior age animals only. Junior horses are five years old and younger and senior horses are six years old and older. The rider may use two hands on Junior horses in all Western Division classes including horsemanship providing that a snaffle bit or hackamore is being used. Animals six years of age or older cannot be shown in a hackamore or snaffle bit. "Hackamore" means that the horse will be ridden only with a rawhide braided, leather braided, or rope bosal; absolutely no iron will be permitted under the jaws. Hackamore bits are prohibited. Tie downs and cavesson type nose bands are prohibited. Curb chains are permitted, but must meet the approval of the judge. Bandages and boots of any type are prohibited on the front legs

HALTER - classes are to be shown in hand, judged on conformation, balance, fitness, and manner of going.

SHOWMANSHIP - classes are to be shown in hand, judged in a prescribed pattern on technique, smoothness, confidence, and promptness in showing the horse to the judge.

<u>WESTERN PLEASURE</u> - classes are to be shown at a walk, jog, and lope both ways of the ring on a reasonably loose rein without undue restraint. The judge may ask for extended gaits. To be judged on performance, condition, and conformation of the horse.

<u>WESTERN HORSEMANSHIP</u> - classes are to be shown individually in a prescribed pattern (to be posted on show morning) and judged on accuracy and smoothness of the pattern performance, along with correct form and mechanics of the riding position. Judge may, at his discretion, ask all or part of the class to return to perform as a group at a walk, trot, and canter.

TRAIL CLASS - Open to all horses and ponies in the show. Standard tack and proper show attire per respective division that is appropriate for a trail class. Two hands may be used on the reins when riding in a snaffle or bosal only for Western horses 5 years and younger (No tied split reins are permitted). Other disciplines may use both hands on all appropriate bits and reins. Tiedowns, martingales, and mechanical hackamore bits are prohibited. All entries will work individually, no railwork. Credits will be given to those horses negotiating the obstacles cleanly, smoothly, and alertly with style in prompt response of the rider's cues, providing carefulness is not sacrificed. At least six obstacles are to be used, and may include a gate; walk, trot, and/or lope over four poles; and backing around cones or between poles, a bridge, put on/remove raincoat, mailbox, sidepass, carrying an object, and serpentine obstacles at a walk, trot/jog (pleasure gait), and or canter/lope between obstacles. Course will be posted at the show.

If the judge imposes a time limit for the course, the time limit will be announced. If time is called during the course, the entry is excused and their score to that point will stand or count. Finishing within the time limit is not necessarily a criterion for placing; however an entry that does not complete the course within the time limit cannot place over an entry that completed the entire course correctly. The judge may, at his/her discretion, ask the entry to proceed or bypass any obstacle not negotiated promptly or properly. The judge has the discretion to excuse an entry for any combination of three refusals, balks, evading an obstacle, and/or blatant disobedience (kicking out, backing, rearing, and striking) anywhere on course.
