PICKLEBALL TOURNAMENT - COVID 19 GUIDELINES July 17 -19, 2020 at Liberty University LaHaye Center

The 2020 Commonwealth Games Pickleball tournament will be following the Virginia Phase 3 rules for safety. Some of the highlights and important safety measures to keep in front of us during our tournament include the following:

- 1. A sanitized game ball will be given out at the beginning of each match and returned for cleaning at the end of the match.
- 2. Score cards and pens will be used for 1 match only and the pen will be sanitized after each match.
- 3. Spectators are encouraged to wear masks while cheering on players during the tournament.
- 4. Seating will be available following the 6-feet recommendation, other than family.
- 5. All courts will be spaced more than 6-feet apart as well as the players' sitting areas.
- 6. Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the facility and we also recommend using the restrooms for washing your hands more thoroughly.
- 7. Please bring your own water bottles and snacks. There will be a limited supply of individual water bottles and individually wrapped snacks.
