

BB/Air Rifle Competition COVID/Social Distancing Guidelines

Shared Equipment and Supplies:

- 1. No sharing of equipment or supplies is recommended.
- 2. Thoroughly clean/disinfect equipment/supplies immediately after use.
- 3. An adult leader or volunteer with clean hands or gloves should distribute equipment and supplies, then be responsible for collecting the cleaned items after the event.

Social Distancing:

- 1. 6 feet of distance between participants.
- 2. Face Coverings:
 - a. Not required but strongly recommended unless on firing line
 - b. Not recommended for shooters on their firing point
 - c. Strongly recommended for coaches who will be in close proximity to members
 - d. Strongly recommended for vulnerable audiences.
- 3. Firing points and targets will be 6 feet apart if possible.
- 4. 6-foot distance includes tables, bleachers, seating areas
- 5. Observers/Bystanders will be limited on the range. Only coaches and shooters' family/friends will be allowed. It is requested the number of observers for each shooter be limited to insure social distancing.
- 6. Awards will be distributed as soon as possible after the last relay. As long as social distancing can be observed, shooters and their supporters can attend if they want. Awards will be mailed to those who do not wish to stay/attend. Medals will be available for shooters to pick up but medals will not be placed around the shooters neck by another person.
- 7. Hand sanitizer and disinfecting wipes will be available; however, shooters may bring their own.
